After spending numerous years establishing his family built crane business with his brother, John had no idea that this trip would bring about the rise of JLG Industries, Inc. Whilst on their journey, John spent time talking to former business associates whom the Groves stopped to see along the way. These conversations combined with a tragic occurrence-two workers being electrocuted on scaffolding when the Groves were going to the Hoover Dam- John discovered a vast marketplace for a product that could swiftly and safely lift people in the air to accomplish maintenance and other construction services.

Upon returning from their travels, John formed a joint venture with two friends and obtained a metal fabrication business in McConnellsburg, Pennsylvania. In 1970, starting operations with a crew of twenty workers, they designed and sold the first JLG aerial work platform. The business incorporates many of the simple design essentials of that original lift into existing designs.

Since then, JLG Forklifts have come a long way from when Mr. John L. Grove came back from his fateful cross-country journey and since the first JLG aerial platform entered the market. As of today, the business has expanded itself into many different global markets and continues to develop contemporary equipment to ensure that customers are able to become safer and more efficient within their workplace.
